

# Shepherd's Voice

#### Wisdom

If you are a college basketball fan you know the name John Wooden. Wooden was an amazingly successful coach for nearly 30 years, most of them at UCLA, where he won 10 national championships in a period of 13 years. During that span he also had 4 undefeated seasons. It is highly unlikely that those accomplishments will ever be matched again, but the best part of this story is that he was a Christian man known as much for his faith as for his successes on the basketball court!

One of Wooden's well known quotes sounds very much like Prov.1:5. He said "It's what you learn after you know it all that counts." Similarly, listen to Proverbs 1:5 – "Let the wise listen and add to their learning." Specifically, we are talking about one type of wisdom – not the wisdom of the world, but the wisdom of God!

Let me suggest a reading of 1st Corinthians 1:18-31 and 2:6-10. Verse 1:30 sums it up very well: "It is because of him that you are in Christ Jesus, who has become for us wisdom from God – that is, our righteousness, holiness, and redemption."

Do we value wisdom? Do we understand the benefits of wisdom? Do we realize the dangers of lacking wisdom? We may or may not be considered wise in worldly terms, but we certainly want to be wise in spiritual terms! Attend Bible classes! Read God's word! Listen for the Spirit! Look to Jesus!






