"Closing the Gap" Sunday

Our church's fiscal year begins on July 1st and ends on June 30th. This year we have gradually fallen behind our budget. This is not the first time we've fallen behind, and it probably won't be the last. Why are we behind? There have been job transfers, loss of jobs, bad weather, and a variety of other factors that have negatively impacted our weekly contributions. So, on June 5th, as we begin the final month of our fiscal year, we are making a congregation wide effort to "Close the Gap." Will you help?

In Ezekiel's day, God was looking for a person to "stand in the gap." God was looking (according to Ez. 22:30 KJV) for "a man among them, that should make up the hedge, and stand in the gap before me for the land, that I should not destroy it: but I found none." He needed someone, but He found none! He needed a person that would "step up to the plate" in modern day terminology. He needed someone who would understand, "the buck stops here," then "take the bull by the horns," and act.

Currently, we are \$21,000 behind our regular budget. That means if all of us triple up on our weekly regular contribution on June 5th, we can "close the gap!" Will it be easy? No! Will it be a sacrifice? Yes! Can we do it? Absolutely! Some will do more than triple their regular contribution, and others will simply not be able to give anything extra. We are in this together! Just so you know, your elders and ministers have committed to doing our part in "closing the gap." Your deacons have been challenged to do the same. Your leaders are going first! Now it is your turn. Will you plan to be extra generous on June 5th? Help us close the gap!
