FROM DANIEL'S DEN

Our church just blessed 20 families with special cards of Thanks! Thank you for taking the time to write a message and sign your name to the 20 Thanksgiving cards we mailed out this year. The cards went all over the country and across the world, including recipients on four continents.

Science is now proving what God said 2,000 years ago. Giving thanks will improve your quality of life, and may even increase your longevity.

"Thanking others in heartfelt ways – or, even better, helping them – carries long-lasting effects. Canadian researchers found that people who wrote thank-you letters or performed good deeds for a six-week period decreased their pain, upped their energy, accomplished more every day, and improved their mental health for up to six months... Swedish researchers have found that people ages 77 to 90 who chose to be thankful are less likely to dwell on their chances of growing frail. 'When they can't change something, they choose gratitude and focus on what's good: walking on their own legs, still being alive, and living by themselves.'" –Readers Digest (Oct, 2016)
