## THE PLAYFUL BIBLE TEACHER

**As they talked and discussed these things, Jesus himself suddenly came and began walking with them. But God kept them from recognizing him. – Luke 24:15-16**

This month, we celebrate the most important event in Christianity: Easter, the resurrection of Jesus. Without the resurrection, what else is there to our faith? Without the resurrection, Jesus is nothing more than a dead criminal. A couple of the most interesting encounters after Jesus's resurrection happen in Luke 24. During this chapter, Jesus appears to his followers, first to Cleopas and his friend on the road to Emmaus, and second, to "the eleven and those who with them gathered together." These are people who had been with Jesus for at least three years. They had seen his miracles, heard his teachings, witnessed his compassion for the outcasts, and felt the sting when Judas betrayed him. Jesus had been crucified, and they were scared and confused.

When Jesus first appeared to the guys on the Emmaus Road, they did not recognize him. Why didn't they recognize him? They were "kept from recognizing him," and Jesus played along. Why didn't Jesus just say, "Hey it's me. I'm back"? Later, Jesus even "acted" as if he was going to continue walking without them. Jesus seems very playful here. He seems to have fun with his friends, like men do. He messes with them a little. This incident is not out of the ordinary for Jesus. He sent his fishermen friends to catch fish with coins in their mouth. He surprised them on the beach one day. Jesus had fun watching the sudden realization in their eyes, much like many of us enjoy the eyes of a child learning something new. Jesus is playful the way God is playful with his creation. Just look at the platypus! Yet, there is more here than fun and games.

While Jesus is walking with them, he "took them through the writings of Moses and all the prophets, explaining from all the Scriptures the things concerning himself" (24:27). Jesus is physically in their presence, but he talks about the Scriptures with them. Jesus wanted to make sure the disciples understood the Scriptures before he revealed himself to them. Luke writes that God kept them from recognizing him. Perhaps Jesus wanted their understanding of the resurrection to be based not on their personal experience, but on Scripture.

Later in Luke 24, Jesus appears to the remaining eleven disciples, and he again points them to the Scriptures: "Then he said, 'When I was with you before, I told you that everything written about me in the law of Moses and the prophets and in the Psalms must be fulfilled. Then he opened their minds to understand the Scriptures' (24:44-45). Jesus could have simply said, "It's me! I'm back from the dead. Hear my voice. Feel my skin." Instead, he takes the time to lead his disciples back to the Scriptures so they could see what they had missed.

Jesus was playful with his friends and loved to see them learn. He also brought them back to the word of God. Jesus was a playful Bible teacher. He probably would have been the children's favorite. Jesus believed the scriptures were enough to prove who he was, even for the guys who witnessed him alive after his crucifixion. He wanted them to know the Bible and he wants us to know it too. We need to see what Jesus was very concerned about his disciples seeing: that the whole Bible is about him. If Jesus and his friends can be playful with each other WHILE learning the scriptures, we can too. If Jesus thought scripture was sufficient then, they are sufficient now.

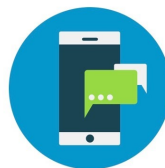
