GENEROUS GIVING

Did you know, there was once a time when the people gave so many resources to the church that they were asked to stop giving? It's true. In Exodus 36, the people were giving so much time, money, resources, and materials to the construction of their sanctuary that Moses literally said they had more than enough, asked the ushers to stop halfway down the aisles, and to stop giving.

Well, I don't know if we will ever see that again, but in spite of bad times, you continue to give and I just want to say "thank you." As a result of your generosity, God is doing some amazing things in our church. Because of your generosity and passion for evangelism since we moved into this building, 97 people have made a public declaration of their faith as they were baptized into the body of Christ.

Through our partnership with Samaritan's Purse, 105 children in under-resourced areas were just blessed by the shoebox ministry. They now have new hope and a brighter future. In the last 10 years, over \$100,000 has been given to sponsor and support our mission trips to France. (And our next mission trip to France is scheduled to depart on June 26, 2021). In the last ten years, tens of thousands of dollars have been donated to support Orphans Lifeline International. During one of the most difficult years in this nation's history, we were able to feed 250 people this year, many which were single mother households. In addition to that, we just provided full Thanksgiving meals for 52 families, including turkeys and fresh pies. You have made over \$6,500 in special donations to support our church pantry this year alone. Also, you just gave \$2,200 to "Choices of the Heart" to help protect the unborn, via the Baby Bottle Campaign. So far this year, you have given over \$20,000 to our Capital Fund, helping to provide for major purchases in and around our building. You not only give financially, you even generously give of your blood (and you can register today for our next blood drive, Sunday, December 13).

I am so proud of you church. When I was at Harding College 50 years ago, I dreamed of ministering to a church in the Northeast, just like us! But more important than me being proud of you, I know God has a smile on His face when He thinks of you and how your generosity is changing our community.

You can give to a lot of worthy organizations who do amazing work, but I don't think there is a better place to invest your resources than right here at Pitman Road Church of Christ. Your resources change people's lives and also have an eternal impact.

Join us here at the building for another American Red Cross Blood drive. You will truly be a blessing, as your donation will be used to save lives. You will also be tested for the COVID-19 antibodies automatically, and will be able to view your results to see if you ever had the virus.

Due to enhanced safety precautions, donors are being urged to schedule an appointment ahead of time so that we can properly manage the donor flow and number of people at the drive.

To make an appointment, call **1-800-733-2767**, or follow the online instructions below.

1. Go to <https://www.redcrossblood.org/give.html/find-drive> and put in our sponsor code: **Pitman Road**
2. Our blood drive date, location, and time should come up. Click on "**See Times**".
3. There, you will choose an available time slot, and whether you will give a regular blood donation or a power red donation. (If you choose power red, you will be giving twice the amount of red blood cells.)
4. Lastly, you will be prompted to either sign in to an existing account or create a new one in order to complete the registration process and secure your time slot.
