Ebenezer Korsah, his family & The Church in Ghana send “Greetings” to all the saints at Pitman Road! There are daily prayers for you! Please remember to pray for us!

**Baptisms:** *There were 14 baptisms at Tutuda and 1 at Stationview in August/September. This brings our total to 33 since our April one startup with PRCC.*

**Tutuda Church Planting:** Looking into the activities program for Adjetey Camp Church, there is a strong desire to help a nearby village to get a church there. A plant is a part of our Goals for 2018 ministry in evangelism. Already we have 5 church members who walk this 11 km distance to church service at Adjetey Camp for over 10 years now. Two times have we visited this village with the word of God mounting our platform for the gospel message. The Macedonian call this time is planned to result in church planting. Already, there some denominational churches located first in this village which to be more powerful and trying to conquer the village with their false doctrines. The people there are confused about how to earn salvation from the scriptural point of view. Base on this we see Christ sending the church there to propagate the truth about salvation in man’s life.

We have arranged for the following to make this Church planting successful; we have contracted with the local school to use a classroom in which to meet; we have provided complete communion supplies with a table, clock, lamp, etc...; we have arranged for local radio commercials and invited the Village Chief and Elders to worship with us; we have brought a team of teachers to spend six days working the area to spread our message. The Van has brought all the audio/video equipment necessary to preach to a sizeable audience. Our Team provided an even meal mid-way through the preaching service. We gave away 60 Christian books and Bibles. We experienced 14 baptisms and the start of a new congregation. What a grand celebration!

**Radio News:** The 6 week radio discussion on the topic “FALSE PROPHETS” has come to an end. Questions that came during phone-in showed that people are interested in such powerful lesson on air. Radio is powerful media for sharing the word of God in Ghana. Another important lesson is about man and money. The Bible says money is a defense. It says that chasing money is the root of evil. Why the two? Both statements need to be explained and understood very well. Hence the next topic, “**MY APPROACH TO MONEY**”, a new lesson started in September on SPLASH 92.9 FM. My aim is to cause life changing from the way and manner human beings run after money in this present age. And I know definitely that God will continue to through me as His servant on earth.

**Cape Coast-Ankaful Psychiatric Hospital:** In mid- September, Ebenezer and 4 other area ministers led the combined congregations’ women ministry to visit the patients at Ankaful Psychiatric Hospital , a part of Cape Coast Mental Health Authority, about 70KM away. We departed early in the Van arriving in Cape Coast about 9am and were warmly received. by the hospital administration; we presented our donation of 20 packages of maize, 12 containers of gari (flour), 270 pieces of soap, very large bag of rice, and a gallon of palm nut oil. Immediately after the donation, we were taken to the wards of the patients for visit with prayers and interactions. When all things are done, the management, staff and clients of Ankaful Psychiatric Hospital expressed their profound gratitude to God and showed much appreciation. They assured us that the gifted items shall be used for the desired purpose for which we donated and urged us to continue to serve the needs of the unfortunate ones.\_

**Family:** It is not easy now in Ghana to be offered admission into Nursing Training Institutions. Yet God made a way for Ebenezer Colley Korsah’s admission. He was invited for the selection interview in late July 2018. He provided his high school records, personal ID’s and school recommendations. Our first-born was accepted as one of 80 out of 3000 admissions; he reported to school on 07Sept and will pursue a Nursing degree. I give glory and thanks to God who has made all possible through long-supporting individuals and PRCC. Colley was appointed as song leader at the college congregation at the Nursing College. Video has been sent to Max to play at PRCC soon.

My second born (Gaius) also started his second cycle institution at Obiri Yeboah Senior High School in Assin Fosu. His program choice is GENERAL SCIENCE to be carried on into university later down the road!

The entire family is blessed by God, and is grateful to God for giving us PRCC.
