"Not So" Newly Wed Game

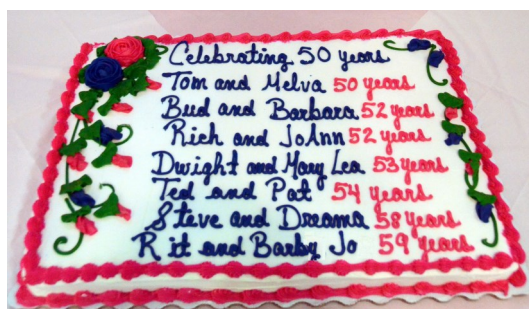
