
From Daniel's Den

Grace is Born...

We started the December "Grace is Born" sermon series with the proclamation that "Grace is our Only Hope." Philip Yancey makes two profound statements on page 70 of his book What's So Amazing About Grace? He asserts: "Grace means there is nothing we can do to make God love us more... And grace means there is nothing we can do to make God love us less." Simply stated: God love us!

I grew up with the image of a God who was kind-of like Santa Class...making a list and checking it twice, trying to decide who's been naughty and nice. Yancey says: "I grew up with the image of a mathematical God who weighed my good deeds and bad deeds on a set of scales and always found me wanting. Somehow I missed the God of the Gospels, a God of mercy and generosity who keeps finding ways to shatter the relentless laws of ungrace. God tears up the mathematical tables and introduces the new math of grace, the most surprising, twisting, unexpected-ending word in the English language."

The messed up, adulterer, deceiver and murderer, David, is actually called a "man after God's own heart." How is that? Grace! A thief that was crucified beside Jesus is forgiven. How is that? Grace! Jeffrey Dahmer, a mass murderer before his conversion, was baptized in the prison whirlpool and was spending all his time reading religious material given him by a local Church of Christ minister. Before his conversion he was an atheist and "so he felt accountable to no one. Nothing restrained him." Then, he met Jesus and learned that someone really does care about him! How is that? Grace!




