

Reading though the Bible in 2016?

Just today I finished my journey from Genesis through Revelation. I've lost track of the total number of times I've read through the Bible, but I'm guessing it's between 12 and 15 times. Not bragging, because many have done it many more times than that! I usually make it through in one year, but sometimes it has taken me two years...and I'm okay with that! (My first time, I read the KJV, and it was my senior year in high school. Reminded me of Shakespeare!)

I usually try to read in a version I've not read through before. This year, I read through the New King James Version of the Chronological Study Bible, published by Thomas Nelson, Inc., with a copyright date of 2008. It was a gift from Katherine last Christmas. It is available in hardback, or in a variety of leather bindings. And, this was my favorite chronological study Bible reading so far. I highly recommend that you read through this very Bible, starting now! Or, if you're not inclined to read it, buy this very study Bible as a gift for someone you love.

It gets even better, CBD has genuine leather copies of this Bible available at a 75% discounted price. They regularly sell for \$129 plus shipping, but you can now buy them for only \$37, postage paid! (They should arrive about 1/15/16). \$37 will hold your copy!
