Unstoppable...BUT..."Houston, We've Had a Problem!"

Our Sunday morning sermon series is highlighting the unstoppable nature of the first century church! Still, in those earliest decades, Christians felt anything but unstoppable. They felt vulnerable. They were at risk! They were mocked! They were persecuted! They were going against the flow! They were minimized and attacked by the Roman government. They were minimized and attacked by the religious leaders within Judaism. And finally, they were minimized and attacked by both the academic community and by the pagan / idolatrous philosophers around them.

After a very exciting birth (Acts 1 & 2), and staggering church growth in the first decade or two, many Christians were likely asking the same question as those three astronauts on Apollo 13 were asking themselves on Saturday, April 11, 1970---46 years ago! Are we going to make it? What is going to happen next? Are we going to die? Those first century Christians were not only being marginalized, they were being persecuted! None the less, they kept spreading the word about this crucified, but "Risen" Christ.

In spite of their life and death struggle, Christianity flourished throughout the first century and into the second and third centuries! Why did it flourish? The Risen Christ attracted believers! Changed lives, lives that had been impacted by this "Risen" Messiah, attracted others to follow Him. A changed life is hard to argue with! When a man or woman has been transformed from who they were to Christ follower, that is downright attractive! A resurrected Christ without a repentant believer is repulsive! Disgusting hypocrisy! A transformed life is like a magnet! God now "commands all men everywhere to repent" (Acts 17:30)!

When we live a penitent / transformed life, we become the 67th book of the Bible. And, the 67th book of the Bible is the only book of the Bible that most of your non-Christian friends read!

I travel up and down the eastern seaboard doing different marine jobs; there are periods of down time that allow me to think about life. I remember a tow I made from NY to Texas. As I made my way across the middle of the Gulf of Mexico I happened to look at the depth finder. It wasn't reading the bottom at its deepest setting. I looked at our position on the chart and realized we were traveling in water over 2 miles deep. Wow! Talk about feeling small. It's times like that you really think about your purpose in life.

Just after that trip I read Rick Warren's book *A Purpose Driven Life*. Day 3 of the book is titled "What Drives Your Life." This chapter talks about 5 benefits to Purpose Driven Living.

Knowing your purpose:

3. focuses your life

1. gives meaning to your life.

4. motivates your life.

2. simplifies your life.

5. prepares you for eternity.

In the years that have passed since that trip, I've seen God's hand at work over and over again showing me glimpses of my purpose. Those glimpses encourage me to INTENTIONALLY have a Purpose Driven Life. Our purpose on this earth should be this: preparing ourselves to meet our Father in Heaven, and preparing others to do the same.

God could ask us a couple questions when we meet Him:

- 1. What did you do with my Son, Jesus Christ? In your Purpose Driven Living did you share HIM?
- 2. What did you do with what I gave you? (Your relationships, talents, gifts, and resources God gave you.)

Think about these questions the next time you're wondering what your purpose is in life. Ask yourself "Am I Living a Purpose Driven Life? Proverbs 19:21




TODAY!

- This film is rated PG-13 and has a running time of 1 hr. & 47 min.




Bring a Friend this Easter!
