## 27 Shirt Hangers and 12 Pant Hangers

I got new clothes for Christmas this year. How about you? I got new slippers, two new sweaters, new socks, as well as a beautiful new shirt and two ties. Beautiful clothes. But, when I attempted to put all my new stuff away, it wouldn't all fit into my closet. Remembering Jesus' story about the farmer tearing down old barns to build new barns (Luke 12:18), I decided not to build a new closet. By the time I cleaned the closet (between Christmas Day and New Year's Day), I'd given away 27 shirts and 12 pairs of pants. It felt so good! How do I know how many shirts and slacks I gave away? I counted the 39 empty hangers after my purge.

If you want to feel better about yourself as we enter 2017, clean your closet. Get rid of some of your stuff. Do our possessions possess us? Don't clean out my closet. Don't clean out your spouse's closet. Clean YOUR closet (Matt. 6:28-29).

And speaking of cleaning out stuff, how about getting rid of some other stuff in your life? Trash those **words** that do not belong in a Christians vocabulary...trash them. We will answer for every word we speak. (Matt. 5:37)! Clean out your closet! Those **web sites and photos** that clutter your mind and tantalize your eye with pornographic trash, clean out your closet...and focus on pure thoughts (Matt. 5:8). That **anger** you have buried deep in your heart...trash it! Take all those **grudges** and throw them in a trash bag! Clean out your closet! If you do not forgive others their trespasses, neither will your Father forgive your trespasses (Matt. 6:14-15).

Want to feel better about yourself in 2017? Jesus says, clean your closet! Get rid of some stuff! You can do this! Jesus will help! One Monday night last year at the Monday Night Men's Study a brother told the other guys how he once talked, the filthy words he once used. Then he said, "since I started coming to this church, I don't talk like that anymore." He cleaned his closet!

## On Being Partners in Serving the Homeless

**"Whoever is kind to the poor lends to the LORD, and he will reward them for what they have done." Proverbs 19:17**

On one given night, January 26, 2016 (almost exactly one year ago), the Point-In-Time Count by Monarch Housing Associates found a total of 61 household, including 112 persons, were experiencing homelessness in Gloucester County. And a significant number of those people were children.

In partnering with Family Promise in Gloucester County, we are helping to serve many homeless families, especially those with children. In the 11 years since the beginning of the program, Family Promise has served over 150 families, including 500 individuals, most of those being children. For most of 2016, each week, 4 families were being accommodated; averaging about 12 individuals. Family Promise, along with churches like our own, provided shelter, food, transportation, social services, parent education, and fellowship. The goal is not only to serve those who have found themselves homeless, but to also to assist them in securing employment, housing, and independence. Our Pitman Road efforts with Family Promise are making a real difference for real people with all too common economic hardships.

As we approach our first Family Promise Host Week of 2017, consider being a part of this ministry that has had such a great impact in our surrounding community, so that in this coming year we can reach out to even more families struggling with homelessness. **You can start by signing up in our lobby for any one or more of the many open volunteer slots for January 22nd-29th.** If you need more information, please see John Ashton or Mary Collier.

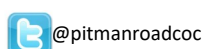
