Our goals for this quarter:

• Practice daily time with God this quarter.

God does some of his best work in our lives when we are quiet. Here are four key elements you should include in your daily time with God: stopping, centering, silence, and scripture. Ideally, practice daily time with God 1-3 times daily for 5-15 minutes

•Rest 1 day out of every of 7 days this quarter.

God has given us a wonderful gift in the Sabbath rest. It is about resting from work so you can enjoy what God has blessed you with through your work. It is the pause that refreshes. Ideally, you should rest one day out of each week, whichever day works best for you, and do something you enjoy. Rest may not "look" the same for everyone. For some it be a long nap. For others, it might be mountain climbing. Rest in this case is something positive that you enjoy that helps refresh and renew your mind and soul.

"LYING, EVERYBODY'S DOIN' IT ... HONEST!"

That was the cover story in TIME Magazine on Oct. 5, 1992. People are dishonest. They lie. They fib! In case you hadn't noticed, fake news is rampant! The TIME article from twenty five years ago observed how prevalent dishonesty and lying had become in American public life. And, it if anything, it seems to have gotten worse! The article went on to suggest that it's gotten to the point where we don't even expect people to be honest. Politicians are likely the first to be called out for dishonesty. The Time article stated, "Thomas Jefferson and Franklin Roosevelt both promised to shrink the government's powers when campaigning, and both men expanded those powers as president." More recently, our presidents were caught red handed lying. ("Read my lips, no new taxes..." "You will be able to keep your current health care plan...") But lying politicians are nothing new.

But it is not just politicians that lie! Students lie and cheat. Teachers are rightfully troubled by numerous studies showing that virtually every student cheats. Parents routinely tell "white lies" to their children. The IRS knows that American's are prone to lie about their income and/or expenses, so the IRS audits tax returns. Businesses routinely do audits, and among other concerns, audits are done to insure that employees are telling the truth! As we re-think the Sermon on the Mount (Matt. 5:33-37) Jesus says, "All you need to say is simply 'Yes' or 'No'; anything beyond this comes from the evil one." Liars face a certain judgment! John said, "But as for the cowardly, the faithless, the detestable, as for murderers, the sexually immoral, sorcerers, idolaters, and all liars, their portion will be in the lake that burns with fire and sulfur, which is the second death." (Rev. 21:8) Bam! Liars face a certain judgment. What should our response be? "Speaking the truth in love, we are to grow up in every way into him who is the head, into Christ." (Eph. 4:15)
