Re-Thinking the Sermon on the Mount...

secret will reward you.

Katherine and I have visited the traditional site of the Sermon on the Mount in Israel a half dozen times. It is always a rich and deeply moving experience. God willing, we're leading another group in May, 2017 if you want to join us.

Carlos and I are now two months into the **RETHINK** sermon series, and we're still going deeper. At a first reading, the Sermon on the Mount is so simple. Live the "golden rule." Pray simple prayers. Don't commit adultery! Don't steal! Don't worry! Bless others. Go the extra mile, even for people you don't like. I mean, I grew up with all of that stuff! How complicated can it be?

But spend more time in the sermon and you'll discover it is profound and convicting! It will cut you to the heart. This sermon takes us deep! It's not just what we do that matters to Jesus, but even more why we do what we do!

So, give generously, but don't give and make a BIG DEAL about it. In fact, give so secretly, so spontaneously, that your right hand doesn't even know what your left hand is giving. Keep your giving a secret. And when you pray, just pray simple prayers! No need to memorize your prayers. Keep them secret and simple. Go into your closet to pray in private. And don't feel that using big words will somehow make you more spiritual. Rather, when you pray just honor God, and thank Him for your food, pray about His kingdom, for deliverance from temptation, and for your need for forgiveness. When you fast (and He seems to expect that we will fast), just go about your business without drawing attention to yourself. Wash your face, dress like you normally would, and the Father who sees in

Women's Friendship Friday!


