Today begins the second of our four Family Promise Host Weeks for 2017. We ask that you respect the privacy of our guests, and do not enter their designated rooms for the week. We also want to thank the dozens of people who have volunteered to serve our guests for the week.

If you are not familiar with Family Promise of Gloucester County, it is an interfaith program of area congregations that provide shelter, dinner, and companionship for homeless families with dependent children. Up to 14 people are housed overnight on a weekly rotating schedule through the various congregations. . During the day, families have access to the Family Day Center. There they have access to laundry and shower facilities, food for breakfast and lunch, computers for homework, etc. They are provided support and assistance through case managers who assist and empower them to gain employment (if they are unemployed) and to once again obtain housing.
