How Can We Help?

Currently, parts of the state of Texas are being devastated by Hurricane Harvey. You only need watch the news to see the effects. Tens of thousands are displaced, and now the coastal Louisiana area is poised to face this hurricane as well. Members are asking how we can best help.

Almost five years ago, Hurricane Sandy hit New Jersey, causing unprecedented damage. The Pitman church became a depository of financial assistance from churches across the country. We were entrusted to use these funds to support those who suffered the effects of the storm, and we worked hard to be good stewards of those donations. Now it's our turn to entrust our support to someone else. If you are seeking an organization to donate to, I am recommending that you send your monetary donations to **Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort** (CCDRE). Our deacon responsible for our Caring and Sharing Ministry, **Larry Kellum, Jr**. has authorized that we send \$1,000 to CCDRE out of that ministry's budget. Churches of Christ Disaster Relief Effort is actively responding across Hurricane Harvey impacted areas. CCDRE associate directors are on site in Texas and Louisiana helping to identify needs. On August 28, CCDRE sent three trucks to the area damaged by the eye of the storm, and are currently preparing to send more to Texas. Trucks are headed to Louisiana in the next few days; additional trucks will be sent as needs are assessed.

God bless you for your hearts and interest in reaching out to those in need. Because of our buying power and purchasing agreements, each dollar that CCDRE receives allows us to purchase three dollars in supplies. We anticipate that this event may be one of the largest and costliest in CCDRE history. We will post activity on our website: disasterreliefeffort.org.


