# Scriptures for COURAGE

"Whatever happens, conduct yourselves in a manner worthy of the gospel of Christ...without being frightened in any way" (Phil. 1:27-28).

In the estimation of the scriptures, more bad life decisions are made on the basis of fear than any other motive. To live as a Christian is to be different. That means living courageously with a calm assurance borne of knowing God is with us. This confidence is available to any Christian because it is based <u>on the LORD</u>, not our own abilities or opinion. If you look to the news every day your will live in fear; if you look to the Lord you will know inner peace.

In Your bible, look at where the focus is:

"Be strong in the Lord and in His might power" (Eph. 6:10). The LORD is my light and salvation- whom shall I fear? The LORD is the stronghold of my life- of whom shall I be afraid?" (Psalm 56:4).

"In God I trust and am not afraid. What can mere mortals do to me?" (Psalm 56:5).

"So do not fear, for I am with you; do not be dismayed, for I am your God. I will strengthen you and help you; I will uphold you with my righteous right hand" (Isa. 41:10)>

"The Lord is my shepherd, I lack nothing.... Even though I walk through the darkest valley, I will fear no eveil, for you are with me" (Psalm 23:1,4).

"For **the Spirit God gave us** does not make us timid, but gives us power, love and self-discipline" (2 Tim. 1:7).

"Be strong and take heart, all you who hope in the LORD" (Psalm 31:24).

"Peace I leave with you; my peace I give you....Do not let your hearts be troubled and do not be afraid" (Mark 5:36).



There is nothing in the news, or society, or life that can ultimately harm you. god is for you. He is with you, and nothing can stop that. You belong to Him and He will take you to heaven because you are forgiven through Christ. You really are alright! It's your privilege to live courageously! ## At the Crossroads

Each of our days are filled with a series of choices – some small and seemingly insignificant, and others large and imposing (maybe following a death, or a job loss, or a serious illness). And periodically, those that appear insignificant turn out to be hugely important. So, how do we know the path to choose?

- 1) Often we are commanded to choose, with a clear indication of the better choice:
  - Choose this day whom you will serve Joshua 24:15
  - Choose life Deuteronomy 30:19
  - Choose what is right Job 34:4
  - Choose the good Isaiah 7:15 and 16
- 2) Sometimes we are given a clear indication of which would be the wrong choice:
  - Do not be unequally yoked with unbelievers. For what partnership has righteousness with lawlessness? 2 Corinthians 6:14
- 3) Other times we can follow brothers and sisters on the path who are full of the Spirit, experienced, and living out the "pattern" of Christ in their lives:
  - Be imitators of me, just as I also am of Christ. 1 Corinthians 11:1
  - Join in following my example, and observe those who walk according to the pattern you have in us. Philippians 3:17
- 4) And still other times we "just know", because all the indicators surrounding the decision become clear and unambiguous
  - Your Teacher will not hide himself anymore, your eyes shall see your Teacher. And your ears shall hear a word behind you, saying, "This is the way, walk in it," when you turn to the right or when you turn to the left. Isaiah 30:20-21

In all these situations, there is one thing in common – we need to be keenly attuned to God's will. We must <u>stand</u> (stop what we're doing, get rid of distractions), <u>look</u> (examine our choices carefully, applying Godly criteria), <u>ask</u> (pray, question, study), <u>listen</u> (seek advice and guidance, don't toss aside what we don't want to hear), <u>believe</u>, and <u>get moving!</u> God is not out to confuse us, play jokes on us, or create stumbling blocks in our decision process. He wants us to choose the best way forward in every situation. — **Andy**
