Text Message Alert System

We are continuing to set up an automated system for sending out text messages to the mobile phones of members for emergency or weather related church closings, and to communicate other urgent information. For example, we used this new system to announce the cancellation of Wednesday Night classes the week before last due to icy road conditions. These automated text messages will <u>only</u> be sent in urgent situations. All other communications will continue to be sent to member email accounts.

In order for us to add you to the **Text Message Alert System**, you need to send an email to andym@coChrist.org with the following information:

- Confirmation of your mobile phone number.
- The name of your mobile phone service provider (e.g. AT&T, Verizon, T-Mobile, Sprint, Boost, Cricket, MetroPCS, US Cellular, etc.)



The reason why we are requesting your mobile phone provider is to allow the church to use the FREE text messaging gateway that each mobile phone service provider is required to have. These messages will be FREE for the church TO SEND. Under most mobile phone provider contracts, they should also

be FREE for you TO RECEIVE, but some pay-as-you-go and non-mainstream providers MAY CHARGE you for receiving these messages. Please check your contract to be sure.

If you want multiple family members to receive texts from the Text Message Alert System, please provide the above information for <u>each</u> member of your family who you want included. **Only members who provide the above information will be included in the church Text Message Alert System.**

JoAnn Ruhland, broken bones in her leg and foot.


We Extend Our Sympathy
