

Our church's mission is bigger than making it to the Super Bowl! And, this past Sunday we were eye witnesses to the beginning of a dramatic transformation. **Doug Oliver** wrote...

I am the most stubborn person ever. I am the most incorrigible person ever. I make excuses for everything.

I delivered oil for 27 years, the last 21 years in Camden. I have been robbed at gunpoint three times. I have been hit over the head with a gun butt and received a concussion. I delivered oil to drug dealers; they trusted me. I've done marijuana and crack cocaine. I've seen a man shot to death. I've shown no fear. I've used coarse and vulgar language. I have made friends that are pure evil. But I did not belong there. I was a very lonely man. I prayed to God for help.

Now, since my pancreatic cancer diagnosis and my successful surgery, I've been given a second chance, and I'm not going to squander it.

I have sinned big and monumental sins. I have beat up people and people have beat me up. For a long time I just wanted to die. At this moment I am not fighting cocaine addiction, but I am dealing with the effects of morphine, which was used to treat my extreme pain while I was in the hospital. In the last few days, I have made peace with my son, with whom I have not spoken in over 20 years. God gave me the strength to apologize to him. God is gracious.

I want my mom and dad to forgive me and to be proud of me. Many years ago my dad was an elder at this church. I want to honor him. The last few weeks I have turned my life around. I now ask God to forgive me and I want this congregation to forgive and pray for me.

At the Crossroads

Why Am I Here? Does My Life Matter? What Is My Purpose?

Most Christians find themselves asking questions like these at various points in their lives. Often, when life's burdens become difficult to bear, perhaps because of death, pain, illness, or other stressors, we can question our reason for being. Such thoughts are placed in our heads by the devil, the father of lies (John 8:44) and ruler of this dark world (Ephesians 6:12). As Christians, we should not be deceived. God's word is a lamp unto our feet (Psalm 119:105), providing us clear and unambiguous answers to such questions. In his book *The Purpose Driven Life*, Rick Warren summarizes the five reasons why we are on this earth:

- 1) For God's pleasure "[God] created everything, and it is for ... [His] pleasure that [we] ... exist and were created." (Revelation 4:11b)
- 2) <u>To be part of God's family</u> "God's unchanging plan has always been to adopt us into His own family by bringing us to Himself through Jesus Christ." (Ephesians 1:5)
- 3) <u>To become like Christ</u> "As the Spirit of the Lord works within us, we become more and more like Him and reflect His glory even more." (2 Corinthians 3:18)
- 4) To do God's good works "we are God's masterpiece. He has created us anew in Christ Jesus, so we can do the good works he planned for us long ago." (Eph 2:10)
- 5) For the Gospel mission "The most important thing is that I complete my mission, the work that the Lord Jesus gave me to tell people the Good News about God's grace." (Acts 20:24)

It's not about ME. It all begins and ends with GOD. We were born BY his purpose and FOR his purpose. That is why we're here. And that is why our lives matter.


It has been an honor for me to serve the congregation in a part-time capacity these past months! — Andy


