## That Day!

About one thousand nine hundred and eighty five years ago the most tragic, yet simultaneously the most loving event of all history played out in Jerusalem. A man who had been born to a poor, unwed mother, and raised as a common carpenter, was executed. He was guilty of no crimes. He was a good man, and had done no wrong. He was put to death by one of the cruelest forms of punishment ever known to man. It was barbaric, even savage! He was, without being shown any mercy or compassion, nailed to a cross, and he hung there for hours as he suffo-

cated and was mocked and ridiculed by the crowd. Before he was crucified, he was physically abused, verbally taunted, and mocked. It was so humiliating that most of his closest friends turned their back on him. It appeared the evil one had been successful in destroying the best man that ever lived; Satan was victorious.

**That's the bad news!** You can read the entire story in the Gospel of John, chapters 18 and 19.

But the story does not end there. His torn body was placed in a borrowed grave, and three days later the stone in front of that borrowed grave was rolled away, and that innocent man (if we dare call him a man) rose from the grave. Yes, it was a miracle! The women were the first to see him alive; then the men who had only days earlier denied him discovered the empty tomb (John 20:1-10). He went on to demonstrate that he was alive to more than 500 at one time (1 Corinthians 15:1-11). Join us in that celebration.


