JESUS REPAIRS TOES, HEARTS, AND MORE

"Behold, I am making all things new. Write this down for these words are trustworthy and true." (Revelation 21:5)

Many of you reading this know that I broke my toe not too long ago. I'm confident my toe will heal because our bodies are amazingly designed by a healing Creator. Scabs and scars are evidence of built-in healing. Some parts of our bodies can even regenerate. Although all bones can repair themselves, ribs can regenerate themselves. Ribs are commonly removed during surgeries that require bone grafts in other parts of the body. The rib bone is one of few bones mentioned in Scripture. If you remember, God created Eve from Adam's rib. God chose the one bone that could regenerate itself (which explains why men don't have more ribs than women, not to mention DNA). Our bodies break and heal, but sometimes they are beyond repair. The conditions of our world are similar.

Hurricanes tear through the Gulf of Mexico and flood multiple states. We know they are coming. We prepare for them, but we can't stop them. Earthquakes, tornadoes, famine, cancer, war are all parts of the world in which we live. Creation groans from

the effects of the brokenness. Humanity continues to strive for utopia, but humanity's fallen state makes it impossible to achieve. Just like no one can get eggs out of a cake that has been baked, no one can get the sin out of us and the world; no one, that is, except Jesus. Jesus can repair our bodies and our spiritual hearts, make us sinless in the eyes of the Father. Like our ribs, our spiritual hearts regenerate too (Hebrews 10:16, Ezekiel 36:26). He gives us a desire to live for Him in the midst of the chaos, but that's not all.

He has promised to return to earth to right all that is wrong with this world. John saw a vision of the Lord doing just that and recorded it in Revelation 21. Jesus is going to make everything new. Forty days after His resurrection, He ascended into heaven. At an unknown time in the future, He will descend from heaven in the same form and in the same way that He left. After He returns, He will continue His work of making everything new by giving Christians new bodies, patterned after His resurrection body.

Whereas our current bodies are flawed, weak, natural, sinful, and perishable, our new bodies will be like His – complete, invulnerable, spiritual, holy, and immortal. With the same power He used to raise himself from the dead, He will raise us. He's not going to enter your grave and perform CPR to reanimate your old body. He's going to transform your current one, whether it is alive or dead when He returns, into a glorified one.

Then, with the same power Jesus used to create the cosmos, the world as we know it will be transformed in an instant. Jesus will eliminate the presence of sin, setting creation itself free from its bondage to corruption. And the results will be astounding. Disease will end. Disabilities will be made permanently whole. Discord will give way to constant harmony. Decay will reverse into perpetual growth. Tranquility will replace disorder and success will supplant disaster. Even death itself will die. Revelation 21:4 describes his return in this way:

He will wipe away every tear from their eyes, and death shall be no more, neither shall there be mourning, nor crying, nor pain anymore, for the former things have passed away.

One day everything will be repaired permanently. Jesus is the only one who can save us from all that is currently wrong. Our job is to wait, to worship, to stay faithful, and to partner with him in the mission of regenerating hearts.
