A HOLY CALLING

"I have come to call not those who think they are righteous, but those who know they are sinners and need to repent." (Luke 5:32)

Jesus loves His Father and loves people. Jesus calls us to love God first and love others. We know this, but sometimes I think we forget or ignore something else Jesus taught: repentance.

All the writers of the New Testament address sin and the need to give it up and then avoid it. Jesus, Paul, Peter, and John addressed believers and called them to repent, to transform, to change their life and way of thinking. In fact, the scarlet thread running throughout the entire Bible involves the corruption, consequences, confusion, and catastrophe of sin and the solution God offers with Christ on the cross. God will bring us back into the perfect creation through Jesus, but as we wait for the consummation (final fulfillment) of God's plan, we are called into a transformative relationship of ever-increasing holiness through repentance. Being a part of God's kingdom, having a solid foundation built on the wholesome teaching of the Gospel, receiving forgiveness, growing in holiness to be more like God are all linked with repentance. Here are just some words from Jesus, Paul, and Peter about repentance:

In the same way, there is joy in the presence of God's angels when even one sinner repents. (Luke 15:10)

It was also written that this message would be proclaimed in the authority of His name to all the nations, beginning in Jerusalem: 'There is forgiveness of sins for all who repent.' (Luke 24:47) – Final words of resurrected Jesus

Surely you must know that people who practice evil cannot possess God's kingdom realm. Stop being deceived! People who continue to engage in sexual immorality, idolatry, adultery, sexual perversion, homosexuality, fraud, areed, drunkenness, verbal abuse, or extortion—these will not inherit God's kingdom realm. (1 Corinthians 6:9-10)

The law is for people who are sexually immoral, or who practice homosexuality, or are slave traders, liars, promise breakers, or who do anything else that contradicts the wholesome teaching that comes from the glorious Good News entrusted to me by our blessed God. (1 Timothy 1:10-11)

God has called us to live holy lives, not impure lives. Therefore, anyone who refuses to live by these rules is not disobeying human teaching but is rejecting God, who gives His Holy Spirit to you. (1 Thessalonians 4:7-8)

But now you must be holy in everything you do, just as God who chose you is holy. (1 Peter 1:15)

There are too many other compelling scriptures to include here, but here are a few more to read on your own: Ephesians 4:21-24, Colossians 3:5-10, 1 John 3:6-9.

Jesus had personal interactions with sinners that compelled them to change. Matthew changed. Mary Magdalene changed. Zacchaeus changed. Nicodemus likely changed. Saul changed to Paul. Jesus is the son of God, full of love, truth, and power. We are all works in progress when it comes to being like Jesus, yet Peter says we are called to be holy as God is holy.

Holiness is the calling for someone who has committed to be a follower of Jesus. Holiness isn't something that happens to you; it is something you pursue. God calls you to cut off sin in your life as you pursue a life that reflects His character. The life of God is in you. The power of the resurrection of Jesus is at work in you and that gives you living hope*, but we must continue to examine our motivations and base our beliefs on God's Word.

If our foundation is built on man's word instead of God's Word, we end up with a host of ideas that "contradict the wholesome teaching" of the Gospel and transfer moral authority to man. God wants us to pursue a repentant (transformative) life with him and that begins with knowing and trusting the Word He's given us, all of His Word, from Genesis 1 through Revelation 22.
